Genacross Lutheran Services, formerly Lutheran Homes Society, was founded in 1860. The organization has been meeting the needs of people in communities throughout northwest Ohio and southeast Michigan for 156 years. Today, Genacross serves more than just older adults and youth; we serve people of many ages, across every generation.

In 2015, nearly 3,400 individuals were provided housing and services through the various ministries of Genacross Lutheran Services, a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization.

Genacross Lutheran Services is affiliated with the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA) and recognized by the Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod (LCMS). Genacross is supported by 169 Lutheran congregations throughout the region. Genacross also is a member of Lutheran Services in America, an alliance of the ELCA, LCMS, and over 300 human service organizations.
