Genacross Lutheran Services, formerly Lutheran Homes Society, was founded in 1860. The organization has been meeting the needs of older adults and youth in communities throughout northwest Ohio and southeast Michigan for 157 years. Today, Genacross serves people of many ages, across every generation.

In 2016, nearly 3,400 individuals were provided housing and services through the various ministries of Genacross Lutheran Services, a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization.

Genacross Lutheran Services is affiliated with the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA) and recognized by the Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod (LCMS). Genacross is supported by 169 Lutheran congregations throughout the region. Genacross also is a member of Lutheran Services in America, an alliance of the ELCA, LCMS, and over 300 human service organizations.

Genacross at Home

Our home health agency provides skilled nursing and therapy services to help people recover from an illness or injury in the comfort of their own homes. The agency, which serves numerous counties in northwest Ohio, also offers pre-discharge consultation, medical social services, aide services, and health education.

Genacross Family & Youth Services

This ministry provides residential and community-based treatment, educational services, parental support, developmental disability services, and outpatient mental health counseling to at-risk youth, families, and adults throughout Ohio and the region.
