**Genacross Lutheran Services**, founded in 1860 as a faith-based organization, has been meeting the needs of older adults and youth in communities throughout northwest Ohio and southeast Michigan for more than 165 years. Today, Genacross continues to care for people throughout many stages of life's journey, serving across generations by providing family and youth services, senior independent living, assisted living, memory support, therapy services, and skilled nursing care.

In 2024, nearly 2,000 individuals were provided housing and services through the various ministries of Genacross Lutheran Services, a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization.

Genacross is affiliated with the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA) and recognized by the Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod (LCMS). The organization is supported by numerous Lutheran and non-Lutheran congregations throughout the region and is also a member of Lutheran Services in America, an alliance of the ELCA, LCMS, and over 300 human service organizations.
